

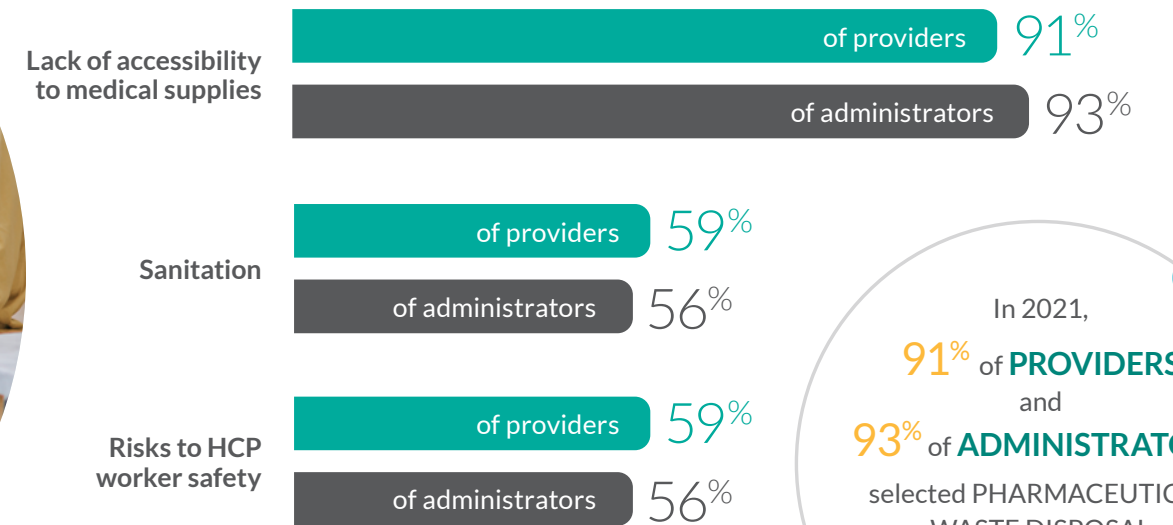
At-Home Care Rapidly Growing Despite Challenges and Risks

Most healthcare workers surveyed agree that at-home care is a growing trend that offers patients select and diversifying services in the comfort of their own home (88% of providers and 84% of administrators). Providers understand that at-home care can provide patients comfort (78%), convenience (71%), and personalized care (60%).

But it's not without its challenges. Eighty-eight percent of healthcare providers are still being asked to deliver top-quality care outside of traditional settings (down from 93% in 2021), leaving many providers (75%) concerned about the risks to their physical health and well-being – consistent with their responses in 2021. Those concerns include sanitation, availability of resources, and their own safety in at-home care.
